This week, the class met the Peace Protectors and learnt that there is a peaceful way to find a win-win solution for disagreements, fights or problems.

What do Peace Protectors do?

- They are committed to finding peaceful, win-win solutions to all disagreements, fights or problems.
- They accept that they are part of the peaceful solution.

After reading the story, we chatted through how we all have a role to play in solving a disagreement, fight or problem so that everyone is happy with the outcome.

Ask your child if they can remember the three types of solutions to disagreement, fights and problems? Refer to page 68 in the CTBF's journal if they can't.

We then looked at eight very use tips for a peaceful solution that will help to create a win-win solution. Children also had an opportunity to share a time that they had a fight with someone and how it made them feel. We acknowledged that we all respond to fighting differently and the children were encouraged to make a point of following the Peace Protectors' tips to help them in their next difficult situation. Remind your child of this the next time there is a sibling fight!
